Instructions: Please read the Accelerated Master's Degree Admission and Standards carefully.

The graduate program director and School Director must sign and submit this form which includes the list of courses identified by the School to meet the undergraduate and graduate dual degree requirements before 1) the bachelor's degree is conferred, and 2) before being considered for an Accelerated Master's Degree. Refer to the Graduate Catalog for programmatic specific standards including minimum GPA and final grade requirements in dual course work. This completed signed form shall be sent to the Dean of the Graduate School for approval.

In addition, and before completing the bachelor's degree, the student must apply for admission to the accelerated master's program. The application is at gradschool.siu.edu/apply. Entry into the accelerated master's program is not a guarantee of admission into the graduate program. Students must enroll into the graduate program within 12 months of their bachelor's degree conferral.
