Use our web-based tool that integrates institutional course equivalency and degree audit data to provide an unofficial credit estimation and a more seamless transfer.

- Apply to SIU** admissions.siu.edu/apply

An application fee is due at time of submission. Some students qualify for application fee waivers. To see if you qualify, contact your admissions coordinator.
- Complete the FAFSA** fafsa.gov

Each year the Free Application for Federal Student Aid is available beginning October 1. We recommend completing your FAFSA right away to optimize your financial aid award. Use SIU Federal School Code: 001758.
- Claim your Network ID and setup your password** netid.siu.edu

Your Network ID (SIU + Your Dawg Tag) is used to access campus resources such as SalukiNet, SIU Online (D2L), computer lab and Morris Library computers, wireless networking, VPN and more. You will need the Dawg Tag # issued with your SIU admission to claim your Network ID. Your SIU email is your primary source of communication with the university.
- Apply for additional scholarships** scholarships.siu.edu

After admission, sign in to the Saluki Scholarship Portal to complete general and supplemental scholarship applications. Supplemental applications are required for our competitive transfer scholarships and some departmental awards.
- Submit your Housing contract** housing.siu.edu

Transfer students with more than 26 hours have the option to live in traditional residence halls, in on-campus apartments, or off-campus.
- Check and accept your financial aid award** salukinet.siu.edu

Log into Salukinet using your Network ID and password to see your financial aid package. You will be able to view the terms and conditions of each item and accept the various types of aid through this portal.
- Register for New Student Orientation** orientation.siu.edu

We have New Student Orientation (NSO) sessions just for Transfer Students! While it is not required for transfer students to attend NSO, we highly encourage it.
- Submit the Immunization Compliance Form** immunization.siu.edu

You can obtain immunization records from your physician, local health department, high school, military branch, or previous university.
- Obtain a parking decal** parking.siu.edu

Students who commute to campus or plan to bring a car must register their vehicle with the SIU Parking Division and purchase a student parking decal.
- Submit official transcripts** admissions.siu.edu

Make it easy on yourself, request that your college send transcripts electronically through an approved electronic transcript service such as Parchment or National Student Clearinghouse. Official transcripts are required and should be submitted as soon as they are available.
- Register for classes** advisement.siu.edu/advisors

Even if you self-register for classes, you must meet with your academic advisor first to obtain a Registration User Number (RUN) and select your courses.
